Association Forensic Odontology for Human Rights (AFOHR)

AFOHR is the first association promoting best practice in human identification and age estimation through humanitarian forensic odontology for the purpose of preventing human rights violations. The need for promoting human rights in the recovery and identification of missing and unidentified persons was first presented by forensic odontologist Emilio Nuzzolese (Italy) at the 9th International Dental Ethics and Law Society (IDEALS) Congress 2012 Leuven (Belgium). This idea gave birth to the group FO4HR-dentifyme on the 5th May 2015 during the Interpol DVI meeting in Lyon (France), which then evolved into association with the new acronym AFOHR (Association Forensic Odontology for Human Rights).

The association is a rooster of volunteer experts in forensic odontology and other areas of forensics from over 30 countries. AFOHR members are helping in forensic casework, teaching, and scientific research in odontology, science, and forensics and are a humanitarian resource when dental evidence is involved in disaster victim identification, missing and unidentified persons, child abuse and neglect, domestic violence and sexual abuse, homicide and torture, age estimation of unaccompanied minors, border control, human trafficking of minors' cases.

Brief Profile

Ademir Franco is a forensic odontologist. In Brazil, he became a dentist and later specialist in Forensic Odontology by the Brazilian Dental Association (ABO-GO). Over the last decade, he studied at Master (Msc), Doctoral (PhD) and postdoctoral levels at the Katholieke Universiteit Leuven, Belgium. Between 2011 and 2021, Ademir published 150 scientific articles and four book chapters. Currently he reviews for over 40 scientific journals and is a member of seven editorial boards (two with a leading position). He participates within international forensic associations worldwide and dedicates his time to forensic dental practice, research and teaching. After working in public and private Brazilian universities, Ademir became a Lecturer of Forensic Dentistry at the University of Dundee. His activities in the field are focused in human identification, dental age estimation, bite mark analysis and malpractice.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT & PROFESSIONAL CATEGORY

Submission of Paper

- The paper should be ORIGINAL and UNPUBLISHED offering new insights, a new approach, or new knowledge to the body of literature.
- The abstract should be of a maximum of 250 words followed by a minimum of 5 keywords in the format given.
- All participants should email their respective abstracts before the mentioned deadline,
 05th September 2021 at afohrsymposium 2021@gmail.com

Criteria for Evaluation

- The evaluation depends upon the presentation skills, content, topic relevancy, and answers given to the jury.
- All abstracts submitted would be published in the **SOUVENIR of AFOHR**.

Presentation of Paper _

- The paper has to be presented in PowerPoint 2013/2010 or earlier in 16:9 ratio slides.
- A maximum of 10 slides is allowed to present. The time limit for the presentation will be 8 minutes followed by a 2-minutes discussion with video 'ON'.
- The presentation should include an introduction, material, and methodology, information regarding collected data, major findings, conclusion, etc.
- In the case of multiple authors, only one author out of the two would be allowed to present the ePoster. All Co-authors would receive the participation eCertificate as co-authors.

Format of Paper: The manuscript should follow the format:

- Title of the paper, Name, Position with Institute name, Contact no. and Email Address.
- Approximately 250 words of abstract followed by a minimum of 5 keywords along with the final paper.
- The paper should follow the font Times New Roman size 12 (Justify alignment) and heading size 14 (aligned centrally) in MS-Word Format.
- All references should follow the MLA (8th edition) style. All tables and figures should be appropriately numbered.

- The evaluation depends upon the presentation skills, content, topic relevancy, and answers given to the jury.
- All abstracts submitted would be published in the SOUVENIR of AFOHR.
